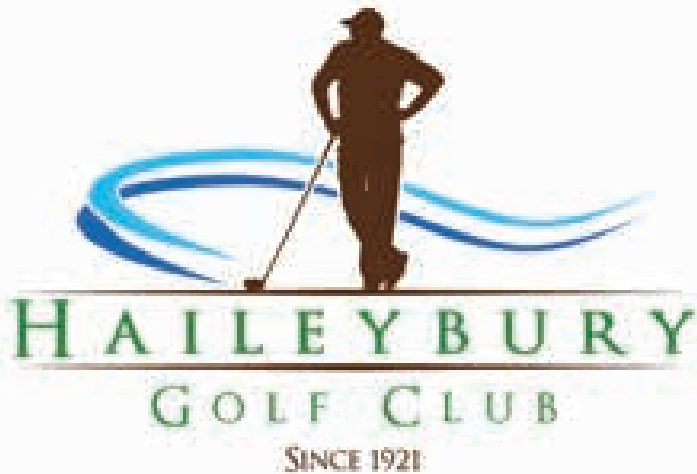

Rural Youth Mixed Slo-pitch League prepares for upcoming season

DISTRICT — Over 550 youth (boys and girls) in the south Temiskaming region will grab their gloves, bats and cleats and head to the area's baseball fields to take part in another Rural Youth Mixed Slo-pitch League (RYMSPL) summer baseball season.

RYMSPL lead organizer, Alex Regele, said projected numbers of youth registered to play Slo-pitch this season in Temiskaming Shores, Kerns, Casey, Earlton, Englehart and Notre Dame du Nord (Temiskaming

First Nation) are at 560 currently.

He said volunteers and coaches with the league are working hard making preparations for the upcoming season.

"With their continued hard work and efforts this league is reaching new heights and our goal of youth participating in Slo-pitch during the summer is being met," said Regele in an email interview.

He said the regular season first pitch will be thrown out by the various teams in the league the week of May 24 with the 8-10 year age group playing every Tuesday at 7 p.m. beginning on Tuesday, May 24. The

11-13 year age category will begin play on Wednesday, May 25 and the 14-17 years category begins Thursday, May 26 at 7 p.m.

T-ball players begin their season on Monday, May 30 and will play every Monday after that until the season finale tournament is held in August.

The finale is called Gate's Gala.

The final tournament was named after Gaetan Goselin, long-time league organizer and volunteer.

Fewer and older farmers minding the farm, who will fill their boots?

According to Statistics Canada, between 1991 and 2011, the number of farm operators in Canada under the age of 55 decreased from 265,000 to 152,000 while the number of older operators increased from 125,000 to 141,000. Moreover, the group of farmers under the age of 35 poised to fill their boots is shrinking rapidly, representing only 8.2 per cent of all farmers.

The trends of fewer operators and fewer farms show no signs of reversing and could indicate significant turnover in farm assets in the future.

In fact, our entire connection to the land is decreasing.

In 1931, when Canada first began tracking farm populations, 3.3 million people, or 31.7 per cent of the population, were living on a farm. By 2011, the farm population accounted for only 2 per cent of all Canadians. In less than a lifetime, Canada has moved from one in three Canadians living on a farm to one in fifty. At the same time, our total population tripled from 10 million in 1931 to 33 million in 2011.

Twice every decade, Statistics Canada asks Canadian farmers and farm operators to complete the Census of Agriculture questionnaire. The data collected are used to give local, provincial and national snapshots of our farming industry and identify trends that need watching.

In fact, the Census of Agriculture is described as "the backbone of Canada's agricultural statistics program, which identifies the who, what, where and how of our food production."

It is vitally important that all Canadians, including farm operators, complete the census; in fact, it's the law.

This year farm operators will be receiving letters in the mail at the beginning of May with instructions for completing the census online or on paper. The questionnaire is shorter and simpler this time and Statistics Canada has also made online completion much easier and faster.

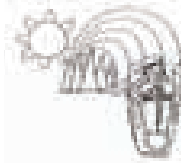

Devices taking education in new direction

TEMISKAMING SHORES – School board officials say a little device means big changes for some Ontario North East students and teachers.

The first year of a new approach to education using iPads at District School Board Ontario North East is wrapping up.

In September, students from grades 7 through 10 were issued personal iPads for use in school and to take home.

"We're into a very, very different world," said Doug Shearer, the board's chair, as he sat in on a recent training session for board staff with an instructor from iPad designer Apple.

"It's not like someone's handing in a written assignment at the end of the day. As the course is progressing, the teacher is assessing on an ongoing basis."

Teachers are finding students are collaborating more, he said.

It's a tool to let students demonstrate to teachers and classmates how they work through a math problem or a literacy exercise, said board director Linda Knight.

Teachers have found that students who were very quiet "are now talking about their thinking, how they're thinking," she said.

And because all students

have iPads, students with special needs who use devices with accessibility features no longer feel singled out, said Chad Mowbray, the board's lead in curriculum, innovation and technology.

EDUCATION FOR ALL

Teachers too are on a learning curve. In some cases, students were more familiar with the technology than teachers.

"I had a comment from one of the teachers that had to learn to let go, and be more of a facilitator than the person at the blackboard," Mr. Shearer said.

"That's what this teacher said: 'I had to learn not to be afraid to let my students lead me.'"

The board is now drafting a survey for parents, teachers and students on how they feel the iPads have changed learning.

Asked if some parents unfamiliar with the devices may feel intimidated, Mr. Shearer acknowledged, "It's one of our challenges."

Mr. Mowbray said some schools have hosted info sessions at parents' nights on the use of the iPad.

He said new software applications were introduced in December that will let parents log into websites to see samples of their children's work, feedback from teachers, and students' responses.

"It invites parents into the

classroom through those applications."

This fall, he said the board is considering evening sessions where students will teach their parents about the iPads' use.

Mr. Shearer said experience in other jurisdictions has pointed to an increase in parent engagement.

"They have a faster way of assessing their children and seeing what is happening."

ONLINE SAFETY

The board is also using the devices to teach "digital citizenship" – the safe, responsible and appropriate use of technology.

Prior to distributing the iPads, Mr. Mowbray said the board did a crash course on issues such as privacy protection, online safety, and the types of materials that could be – or should never be – put online.

Students are introduced to the devices in junior kindergarten, enabling the board to teach responsible Internet use "at a much younger age," Mr. Shearer said.

In September, the board is looking at providing one iPad for every two students in grades 3 and 4 for classroom use.

The distribution of personal devices for use in school and at home, meanwhile, will be extended to students in grades 5 and 6 in September.
