The City of Temiskaming Shores is in the process of creating a new Zoning By-law to cover the entire area of the amalgamated City. The City is currently working under the Zoning By-laws for the former Township of Dymond and former Town of New Liskeard and Town of Haileybury.

The City has engaged the services of Planscape Inc., a land use planning firm from Bracebridge, to undertake this project, which will culminate in the adoption of the first Zoning By-law covering the entire area of the City.


