

The importance of tractor safety

The tractor is one of the most widely and frequently used pieces of equipment on Canadian farms. They're common enough that farmers can often get so used to operating them that they ignore standard safety procedures. Just in time for Canadian Agricultural Safety Week, which takes place March 11 to 17 this year, here are some helpful safety reminders for operating a tractor:

- Do not operate the controls of your tractor unless you are in the driver's seat. According to the Canadian government, nearly half of all of the people killed by being run over by a machine on a farm were run over by unmanned vehicles.
- Do not operate your tractor on ground you know to be unsafe. 36 per cent of fatal sideways machine rollovers between 2003 and 2012 happened because farm workers drove too close to a ditch. Carefully

plan your route to be sure that there are no surprises.

• Do not let anyone ride as a passenger unless the tractor was designed for more than one person. Bystanders and passengers made up a combined 32 per cent of all people run over by tractors. Children were the most likely to be killed amongst this group.

Tractors are powerful tools and they're a great help on the farm. But everyone around tractors should also respect how dangerous they can be. No one plans to be in an accident and we have to be constantly aware of the possible danger to make sure it never becomes real. To avoid disaster, always practice tractor safety, even if it's a little inconvenient.
