

Imagine being 36 years old, a mother of three boys and told you have one year to live unless you have a double lung transplant?

And when a donor set of lung does come available, you undergo the lung transplant only to find out your body has rejected the lungs and in order to survive, you must undergo a second double lung transplant?

All this while having to live away from home in Toronto close to the transplant hospital waiting for a donor set of lungs. This has been Vicky Presseault Pineau's enduring health challenge, not to mention the financial challenges she and her family face while they live in Toronto near the transplant hospital.

She's a fighter, but she can't do it alone....
