The purpose of the application is to amend the list of permitted uses in the Downtown Commercial New Liskeard (C1), Downtown Commercial Haileybury (C1A) and Highway Commercial (C2) Zones to add Micro Brewery/Winery/Distillery as a permitted use accessory to a restaurant on properties in these zones. The definition of micro brewery/winery/distillery would also be amended in order to align with the proposed amendment. The amendment would include ratio and maximum size requirements for these uses in the stipulated zones. The amendment would affect all properties zoned C1, C1A, and C2 including all special exception zones under these categories, within the City of Temiskaming Shores. The amendment would not change the existing micro brewery/winery/distillery permissions in the M1 zone. 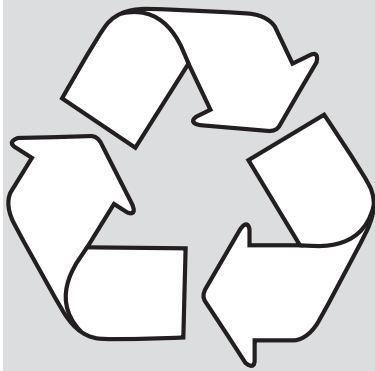
