Cubs double up Minor Trappers

TEMISKAMING SHORES — The New Liskeard Cubs were first to score and first to the puck in most instances when they doubled up the score on the North Bay Trappers Minor Midgets 4-2 on Friday, November 1 at the Don Shepherdson Memorial Arena.

It was all Cubs from the puck drop onwards until the third period when the Trappers scored a couple of short-handed goals.

"We had 15 minutes left and we thought if they score another goal it will be 4-3 and we could be in trouble, but the boys played well and hung in there," said coach Steve Polyblank in a telephone conversation.

The Cubs goalie, Zach Prusky, faced 30 shots in the contest and had a shutout going into the third period, when the Trappers found the back of the net twice.

"Zach has played good for us all season and he's been very solid. He gets square to the puck and the big difference is

when we do get in trouble, our goalies bail us out," noted the coach.

He said goalie Alex Date is currently on the injured list but is expected to return to the lineup in a couple of weeks.

The Cubs have taken nine out of 10 points in their last five games and have played consistent hockey says coach Steve Polyblank.

"It's fun when we are winning and the team is playing good."

Going into the third period the Cubs were leading 4-0.


Both Minor Trapper shorthanded goals came in the third period from Nico Laforge and Dallas Landriault.
