**NOTICE – DEPOSITING/REDEPOSITING SNOW**

As the winter season is upon us, please take note of the following By-Law 2009-159 Being a by-law to regulate removal and relocation of snow in the City of Temiskaming Shores.

SECTION	
3.1	<b>Deposit of Snow</b> <i>No person shall deposit, or cause to be deposited, any snow, ice, or other debris, on any City property or street from off of his or her property or any other private property.</i>
3.2	<b>Re-Deposit of Snow</b>
3.2.1	<i>No person shall move snow within a street or allow snow to be moved from one side of the cleared portion of the street intended for vehicular and pedestrian traffic, to the other side of the street.</i>
3.2.2	<i>No person shall relocate snow within a street or allow snow to be relocated in such a manner as to encroach on the cleared portion of the street intended for vehicular and pedestrian traffic.</i>
3.2.3	<i>No person shall relocate snow within a street or allow snow to be relocated in such a manner as to obstruct the normal visibility or the safe movement of vehicular and pedestrian traffic on the street.</i>

PART 4 PENALTIES	
SECTION	
4.1	<i>Any person who contravenes, suffers or permits any act or thing to be done in contravention of, or neglects to do or refrains from doing anything required to be done pursuant to any provisions of this By-law or any permit or order issued pursuant thereto, commits an offence and except where specifically provided in Appendix "1", shall be liable to a fine not exceeding \$5,000.00.</i>  <i>Where an offence is a continuing offence, each day that the offence is continued shall constitute a separate and distinct offence.</i>

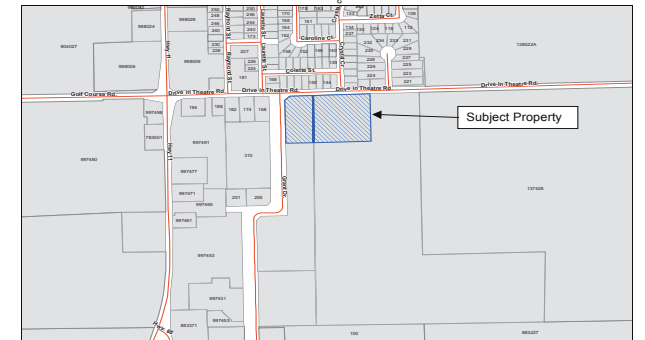

**The purpose of the application is to rezone the subject land from Highway Commercial (C2) and Development (D) to Community Facilities Exception (CF-#)** to permit the development, at full build out, of up to a 256-bed long term care facility in a two-storey building, as well as accessory commercial uses (eg. hair salon, café, gift shop, medical/health practitioner offices, etc.) and associated parking.
