– Haileybury Landfill Tipping Fee Increase

Effective January 1st, 2020, the Tipping Fees at the Haileybury Landfill will increase by one dollar (\$1.00) for categories 1-9. Please see the updated schedule below.

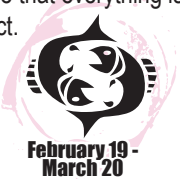

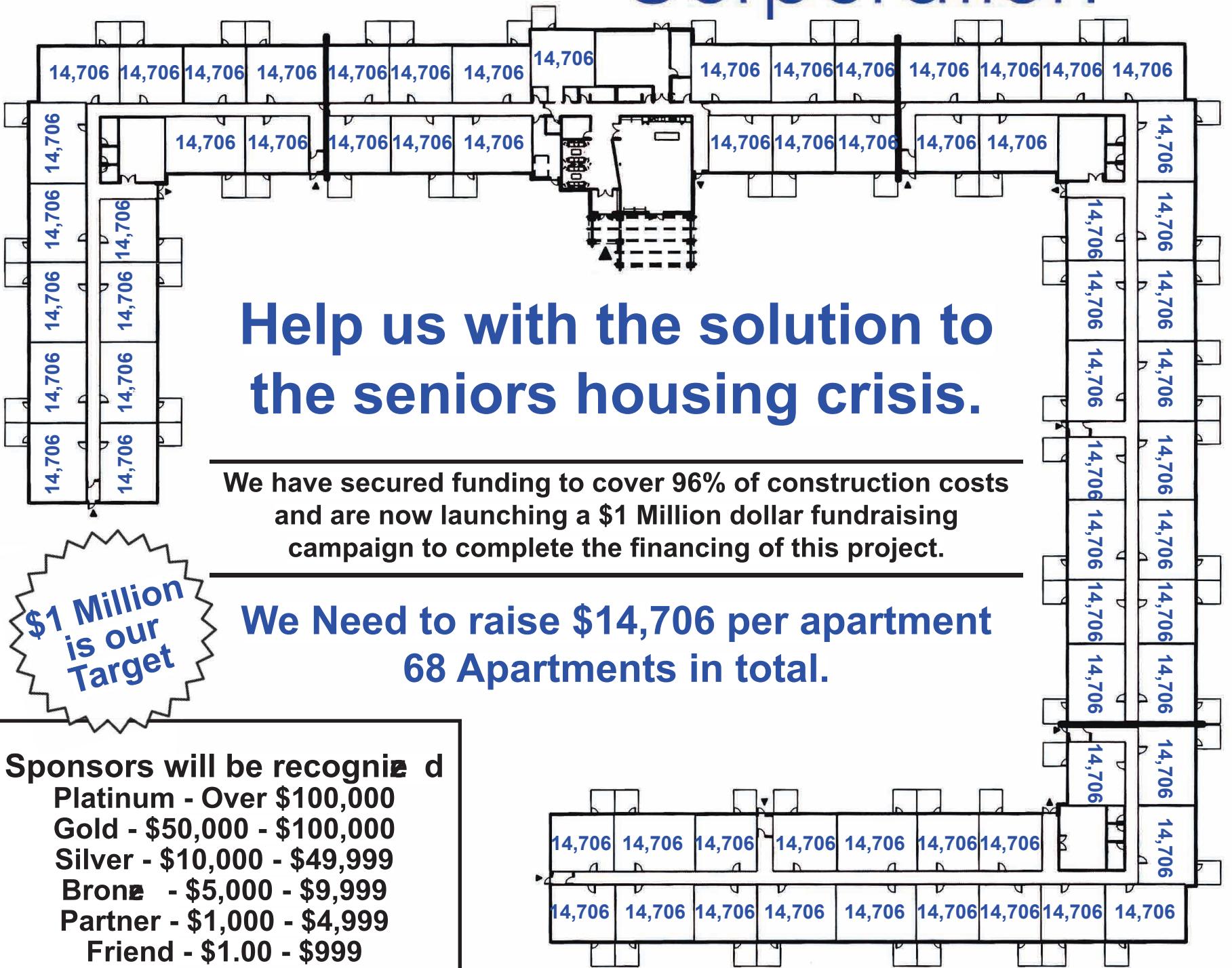

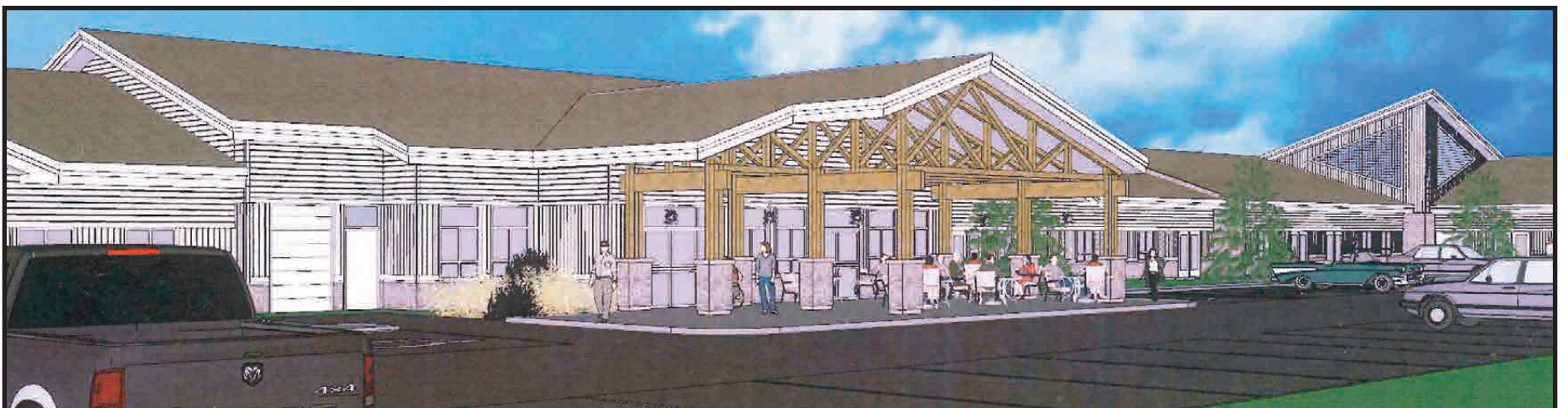

The best strategy is to simply sleep it off. For a cab or a friend's couch, call a friend or family member to take you home.

ENSURE YOUR FRIENDS GET HOME SAFELY

If you notice that a friend or family member is planning to drive even though they've had a few drinks, try to talk them (possibly away from other guests so they don't feel attacked). Offer to call them a cab and, if they become confrontational, get someone to help you. If all else fails, you may need to call the police.
