Burning Permits Required

The Temiskaming Shores Fire Department would like to remind all residents of the following:

- Before burning, all residents are required to obtain a Burning Permit.
- Burning Permits are required each year from January 01st to December 31st.
- Burning during the day **IS NOT** permitted from April 01st until October 31st
- Permitted burn times are between the hours of 6:00 pm and 8:00 am
- Permit fees as follows;

Annual permits: \$20.00 (Renewal only)

Annual permits: \$30.00 (Requiring inspection for new or altered sites)
- Burning permits may be obtained Monday – Friday, 8:30am – 4:30pm.
- At City Hall, 325 Farr Drive, Haileybury (renewals only) or 181 Drive in Theatre Road, Dymond.

Landfill Notice – Haileybury Landfill Tipping Fee Increase

Effective January 1st, 2020, the Tipping Fees at the Haileybury Landfill will increase by one dollar (\$1.00) for categories 1-9. Please see the updated schedule below.

6. Non-Hazardous Waste: <i>Includes clean fill.</i>	\$8.00	\$15.00

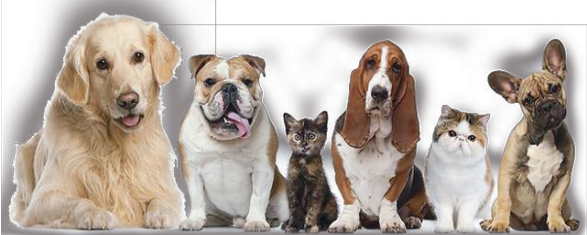

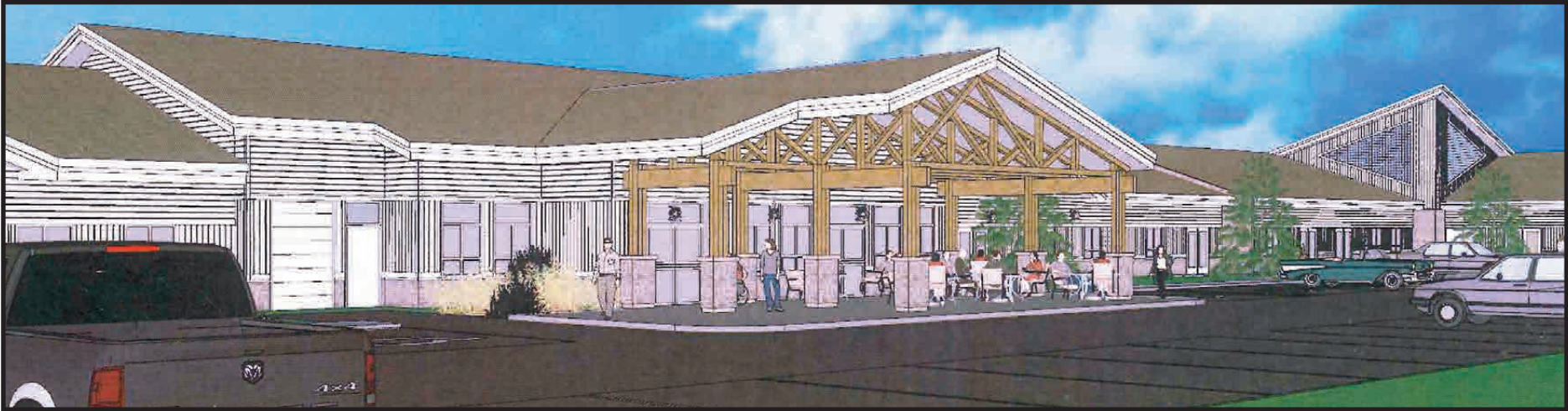
