The Temiskaming Shores Fire Department would like to remind all residents of the following:


- Before burning, all residents are required to obtain a Burning Permit.
- Burning Permits are required each year from January 01st to December 31st.
- Burning during the day IS NOT permitted from April 01st until October 31St
- Permitted burn times are between the hours of 6:00 pm and 8:00 am
- Permit fees as follows;

Annual permits: \$20.00 (Renewal only)

Annual permits: \$30.00 (Requiring inspection for new or altered sites)

- Burning permits may be obtained Monday – Friday, 8:30am – 4:30pm.
- At City Hall, 325 Farr Drive, Haileybury (renewals only) or 181 Drive in Theatre Road, Dymond.

FORESTRY IN TEMISKAMING #ItTakesAForest

Forestry In Temiskaming Tour

Being born and raised in Northern Ontario, I thought I understood forestry. I mean let's face it...I can fall, strip, buck, split, pile, burn and plant a tree just like any true Northerner. But, I quickly found out just how little I really know about modern day forestry or just how many knowledgeable people are involved in keeping our Northern forests sustainable.

It was 7:30 in the morning when I climbed on that bus in front of Temiskaming Shores City Hall on that rainy, cold day last October.

I had prepared for the field trip by digging out my long johns, my steel toe boots, my bush coat, a reflective vest and a hard hat. Checking my image in the full length mirror on my way out that morning I nodded to myself as I thought "Yes, I look like a modern day lumberjack wearing reflective gear that is much too large for me."

Once moving we travelled west on highway 65 into Lundy Township. We turned off and travelled down a windy bush road. This was the spot that

Resource Tech Management Inc was working to complete a timber harvesting contract.

They were not only harvesting the timber but they were building the roads to access the timber. I was excited about that. Trails that would be left to explorefor trail riding, for hunting or to access small lakes...great for outdoor activities and tourism opportunities in our district.

Although I have toured other sites that Al Legros (owner) and his team of 30 full time and contract employees/ operators have harvested, it never ceases to amaze me how perfect the "cut to length" logs are piled on the side of the road. It is literally a work of art.

I was amazed as I watched the operator of the feller buncher expertly embrace the tree, cut the trunk at ground level, lay the tree on its side, strip it of its branches and place the log on the top of the pile. I watched as he gently tapped the end of the log making sure that it was lined up with the rest of the pile. It was amazing how that operator could make a feller buncher look smooth and gentle.

I learned that day that Resource Tech Management uses a harvesting system that does not leave piles of slash along the roadside. Instead, the branches create a layer of ground protection across the forest floor which contributes to natural regeneration.

I also learned that day "RTMI is a major supplier of crown timber to EACOM Timber Corp., harvesting over 25 percent of the requirements for the Elk Lake Mill on an annual basis" Was I impressed? You bet I was.

This was clearly not a clear cut, slash and burn operation that left our northern forest looking raped and desolate. Instead I left that cut area with a sense of peace knowing that it had been treated with a gentle hand, respect and a vision for re-growth, sustainability.

As we travelled to our next stop some of the most knowledgable foresters that I have ever met talked to us about the Timiskaming Forest Alliance Inc., The group consists of a group of forestry based industry partners...big and small. Together they have assumed all forest based management, planning

and operational responsibilities for an area of 10,000 square km of forest land base. This includes forest renewals and maintenance on crown lands. I was shocked to learn that this group plants approximately six million trees a year. I also learned during this discussion about First Resource Management Group. They are a resource management company with one of their five northern offices in New Liskeard. They provide forest management services which include (but are not limited to) planting, erosion control, geographic information or monitoring services. They employ 30 people.

As we pulled into a field piled with five story high mulch piles, with steam coming off the tops, my jaw dropped. I had no idea that this facility existed in our district. This was Gro-Bark. I had no idea that Gro-Bark produced mulch and soil products with feedstock from our northern forest that would otherwise be considered waste. I had no idea that we are one of nine bark mulch and reclaiming sites in Canada. I had no idea that a Gro-bark existed in our back-yard... in Kenabeek.

Leaving Kenabeek and travelling west on Highway 65, we stopped briefly at a jack pine plantation that is 98 years old. Seeing a 98-year-old tree made me wonder how old some of the trees on my property were as they were easily were five times the circumference. Certainly food for thought. At what point does a tree become unsafe?

Our next stop was EACOM Timber Corporation in Elk Lake, which has been in our backyard since 1965. They produce wood studs, primarily used for framing and construction. The lumber they produce is available in a variety of grades from premium to economy.

Here is what impressed me:

-Their priority was not only the safety of their employees, but also us (their guests).

-How they maximized the amount of wood from every tree harvested.

-They have a capacity of approximately 900 million board feet of lumber, and crown land right of 3.5 million cubic meters annually.

-They have 150 full time employees.

-The efficiency of the employees on the line as they examined each unit of lumber.

Here is what surprised me:

-Bark: all logs processed at the mill must be debarked at the mill. The bark is then sold back to Gro-Bark in Kenabeek for the production of mulch.

-Chips: the bi-products are chipped and sold to pulp and paper companies that the material is used for the production of fine paper (such as the newsprint that this is printed on), tissue and cardboard. Other co-products (larger chips) are sold to several northern companies in Northern Ontario and Northern Quebec.

-Shavings: shavings that are produced during the planing process are sold as bedding for domestic animals ranging from horses to guinea pigs to Leis Wood Products in Coleman Township.

-Sawdust: Sawdust that results from the cutting process is sold to a number of wood product companies in the production of fibreboard and other engineered wood products.

EACOM is one of the largest producers of softwood lumber in Canada. They are one of the largest employers in the district and they are in our backyard.

Our final stop was at Georgia Pacific (North Woods LP) OSB mill in Englehart. This OSB mill in Englehart has been operating for over 30 years, however, I had never toured this facility. I have, however used their OSB boards on my personal projects and I knew they produced a quality product.

Here is what impressed me:

-Their priority was not only the safety of their employees, but also us (their guests). We were even offered "freezies" to counteract the hot temperatures. -The amount of different brand names and uses for their products.

-That they have over 200 employees.

-The efficiency of the employees and degree of remote control automation when dealing with the large sheets progressing down the line

Here is what surprised me:

-How you can press one foot of wood chips into $\frac{1}{2}$ " of OSB board. I was in awe of this process and the power it displayed.

-The degree of automation used in the facility.

-The knowledge of the staff through out the tour and that engaged in the discussions after the tour.

-The massive size of the facility.

Georgia Pacific employs over 40,000 people at their more 300 locations in North America, South America and Europe. We are so very fortunate to have them in our district.

Throughout the day from beginning to end when asked about the challenges that the forestry industry face everyone had the same answer.

Lack of younger people entering the forestry field!

Whether it was that it was not being offered as an option upon leaving high school, the insurance companies making it impossible to insure younger people without experience or the young people themselves unaware of the vast opportunities for jobs in the forestry industry...we need to start educating guidance councillors, teachers, parents, politicians and the general population on the benefits of working in the industry.

How have I benefitted from the forestry tour? I now educate people about the industry. I now see the big picture and I have become an advocate for our Northern forests, the foresters and the forestry industry. It is our foresters who monitor our aging forests and invasive species. It is our foresters who utilize every stick of wood that they harvest. It is our foresters who manage our forest so that they remain sustainable. Thank You.

It was truly a fantastic day. It was educational, emotional and fun. I highly recommend that if the opportunity presents itself to you, get on the bus.




