

NOTICE – UNLAWFUL GAMBLING

As per the sections of the Liquor Licensing Act below, AGCO compliance officials must enforce gaming regulations while conducting liquor inspections.

- **Special Occasion Permits** - LLA Reg. 389 Section 32. A permit holder shall not permit drunkenness, unlawful gambling or riotous, quarrelsome, violent or disorderly conduct to occur on the premises to which the permit applies or in the adjacent washrooms, liquor and food preparation areas and storage areas under the exclusive control of the permit holder. O. Reg. 182/11, s. 15.
- **Liquor Sales Licenses** – LLA Reg. 719 Section 45(1). The licence holder shall not permit drunkenness, unlawful gambling or riotous, quarrelsome, violent or disorderly conduct to occur on the premises or in the adjacent washrooms, liquor and food preparation areas and storage areas under the exclusive control of the licence holder. R.R.O. 1990, Reg. 719, s. 45 (1); O. Reg. 230/03, s. 25.

Anyone wishing to conduct any type of lottery (50/50 draw, stub raffle, etc.) at a liquor licensed event or facility **must** obtain the proper lottery license either through the municipality or the province depending on the type required. Note that only eligible non-profit charitable organizations as identified in the AGCO's Lottery Licensing Manual may apply for a lottery licence.

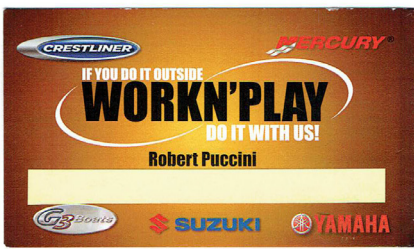

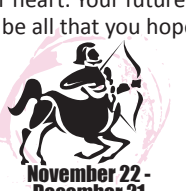
