## Press Release

On March 19th, 2020 the Ontario Clean Water Agency (OCWA), being the operating authority for treatment facilities in Temiskaming Shores, was alerted to a mechanical malfunction at the Niven Street Pumping Station.

Upon arrival at the facility, it was determined that the pumps were malfunctioning and that un-treated sewage was being bypassed to the natural environment.

Upon further investigation, it has been determined that the cause of the malfunction is a result of disposal wipes being placed into the sewer system. While it is important that each and every resident is ensuring their health and safety by disinfecting their surroundings, these wipes should be disposed of in the proper manner.

Paper products, as well as cloth-like wipes, should not be flushed from your toilets into the sanitary sewer systems. These blockages and malfunctions can and will eventually lead to severe issues such as flooding of the systems, which may back-up into buildings including residences. Toilet paper, by its nature, is manufactured to break down within the sewer system within a very short distance of being introduced from your toilets. Facial tissue, paper towels and other household products should never be flushed into the system.

Currently, City staff and the Ontario Clean Water Agency are working to rectify the situation and are asking residents to refrain from disposing items into the sanitary sewer system that are causing these issues.

If you currently have a suspended driver's license, your fine can be paid at Service Ontario located at 280 Armstrong Street, New Liskeard, Ontario or 10 Government Road East, Kirkland Lake, Ontario or pay online at [serviceontario.ca](http://serviceontario.ca)

If you are dropping off Extension of Time to Pay forms or Reopening documents, these can be left in our drop box located at city hall. There is an Order made by the Chief Justice pursuant to s. 85 extending timelines for applying for reopenings (s.11), when a fine is due (s. 66) and when a fine goes into default (s. 69). The extension is granted until April 23, 2020. Unless your matters went into default prior to March 16, 2020, the applications are not considered urgent. Courts are cancelled until further notice. You will be advised of your next court date in writing.

#### How long will they remain closed?

There is no set date for the facilities to re-open. We will continue to update residents and users.

#### Can I get a refund for cancelled hall or facility bookings?

Yes, we will be providing full refunds.

#### What happens to my Pool and Fitness Centre membership?

We will honour the membership once the facility re-opens for the length of time it has been closed.

#### Will I have to pay late fees for items I have loaned from the Library?

No, all late fees will be waived during this period.

#### Will my garbage and recycling still be picked up?

Yes, garbage and recycling curb side pick up is still operating as normal.

#### Is the landfill still open?

Yes, the Haileybury landfill is still open during regular hours.
