Practicing Shot

Name: Jeffery Smith
 Age: 10
 Town: Englehart



While I'm home during the pandemic I am doing school work and also practicing my shots so that I can get better at hockey. The first thing I do is collect my pucks and push them to the back of my shot board which is a white piece of hard plastic that lays on the ground in my backyard about the distance to the blue line on an ice surface. I line them up and then warm my hands up with one puck by stick handling and doing toe drags. That is when you use the tip of the stick (the toe) to drag the puck towards you and flick your wrist up to stop it. I also use a passer which has a big rubber band that bounces the puck back to me to make quick wrist flick movements. And I use a saucer kit, which is a little net that has a small ramp in the front to practice a saucer pass. A saucer pass is a pass that uses the heel of the blade to get the puck off the ice and lift the puck over the opponent's stick to land at your teammate's stick (a tape to tape pass). Shooting the puck can be done in many ways, but I like the CB (slapshot or clap bomb) the best. I am right handed and I use a P29 curve, CCM quick release, 65 flex stick. I use a mid-blade toe tape job for the blade of the stick and I wrap the knob about 6 times around the top and go down about 15-20 cm from the knob. I like to shoot at different times of the day and usually go out a lot. I like to play with my brother and if I was allowed right now, I would shoot with my friends on the road. We take turns shooting and play a game of sauce. A game of sauce is when someone calls out a trick and then has to do that trick. They either make it by doing the trick and then the other player has to do it, or they don't make it and the other person gets to call out a new trick. If the other person doesn't make the shot they get a letter to spell the word SAUCE. If they get the shot, it is now their turn to call out a new shot. "10 shot" is one of the challenges that I do with my friends. My friend Andre started the "10 shot Challenge". He shot 10 pucks and then nominated three people and one of the three people that Andre picked was his brother and his brother shot 10 pucks and then nominated me. Then I shot 10 pucks and then nominated three other people and it kept on going over Facebook. Another thing I like to do is the Backhand Challenge. Jackson

and I stand on the side of the borders of the shot board and we shoot on the back of the blade on the stick. Snapshot Challenge is another good one. You use the toe of the stick. You basically do a toe drag and you shoot the puck together at the same time. A real skill based game is Target Challenge. You try to hit the targets more than the others. The final game we play is Slapshot Challenge where you raise your stick in the air with both hands on the stick and then you hit the puck with all your force. These are some things we do during COVID-19.
