



CITY BULLETIN



Municipal Playgrounds, Sports Fields, and Trails Closed

All outdoor recreational amenities, including municipal playground structures, park shelters, tennis courts, basketball courts, sports fields and skate parks within the City of Temiskaming Shores are closed.

Also closed are trails at Pete's Dam Park and Devils Rock and walkways at the New Liskeard Waterfront and Haileybury Waterfront.

The STATO trail is closed between Wellington St. South and Beach Blvd. in New Liskeard and Browning St and City Hall in Haileybury. All other portions of the STATO trail are open to use at your own risk.

RESTRICTED FIRE ZONE

The Ontario government has taken action to protect people and communities from the risk of preventable human-caused fires and to ensure that the province's emergency response system remains strong during the COVID-19 outbreak.

As of April 3, 2020, Ontario declared a Restricted Fire Zone which includes the City of Temiskaming Shores. Under a Restricted Fire Zone, all burning permits issued in the City of Temiskaming Shores are suspended and it is now illegal to have an outdoor fire—this includes burning of grass, debris and campfires, even when using an outdoor fire grate, fire place or fire pit.

Everyone must make alternate provisions for cooking and warmth, such as using propane stoves or charcoal burners intended for that use. The Restricted Fire Zone will remain in effect until further notice, and until Ontario's ability to respond to emergencies is no longer impacted by the COVID-19 outbreak.

LANDFILL AMNESTY

The Amnesty Program will run for 2 weeks commencing Tuesday May 5th to Saturday May 9th and Tuesday May 12th to Saturday May 16th with the following conditions:

- Hours of operation will be 8:30 am to 4:30 pm;
- Vehicle access within the Landfill will be restricted to support physical distancing; and
- Normal Amnesty Program restrictions/conditions will apply and can be found on the City's website.

Updates associated with the future operation of the Landfill will be provided prior to the conclusion of the Spring Amnesty Program on May 16th. The City apologizes for any inconvenience the temporary closure had but appreciate your comments, concerns and continued support!

Curbside collection of garbage and recycling will continue as normal

MAY 15[™] TAX INSTALLMENT

The second installment due date for the 2020 Interim tax bill is May 15th. Council is encouraging all taxpayers to make the May 15th payment; however, if a taxpayer is not in a position to do so penalty will not be applied to any unpaid taxes effective May 15th.

If a taxpayer has already made payment arrangements for the May installment, i.e. postdated cheque or pre-authorized payment plan (installment or monthly plan); it is the responsibility of the taxpayer to contact the finance department in writing at finance temiskamingshores.ca to cancel these payment arrangements. 


