

FORESTRY IN TEMISKAMING

#ItTakesAForest

Forest renewal not just a spring activity

DISTRICT (Staff) - Tree and seed planting took place across the Temiskaming Forest and Temagami Forest this spring, and forest renewal work will be continuing on through the summer, although through other activities.

Jack McClinchey, a silviculture forester with First Resource Management Group, communicating through an email, explained the activities that have been taking place, and will be continuing through the summer.

"When we try and regenerate any stand the goal is to emulate how the stand would regenerate after a natural disturbance. This usually means regenerating the stand to a condition relatively similar to its pre-harvest condition."

Some harvested areas have more trouble regenerating without assistance, and that's where forest renewal efforts are focused.

"We focus our renewal activities such as mechanical site preparation, tree planting, or aerial seeding on sites that are incapable of regenerating themselves naturally." he said.

"Hardwood stands in the Temiskaming region, dominated by poplar and sometimes white birch, regenerate themselves naturally post-harvest. Poplar stems will sucker off of the roots of a harvested parent tree, while birch and red maple will sprout off the stump. Stands that are mixed with conifer or conifer dominated in upland areas have difficulty regenerating themselves naturally. Jack pine, and to some degree black spruce, are adapted to fire to renew themselves. Fire burns off the duff layer exposing mineral soil, which creates receptive seedbeds, and it also opens serotinous cones (cones that require heat to open). After harvesting operations there is far less mineral soil exposure, and while some serotinous cones will open on the ground, the seed release is considerably less than post-fire. Harvesting activities also promote more hardwood regeneration on mixed conifer/deciduous sites, as machine travel atop poplar roots will result in wounding, triggering aggressive suckering. On these sites we will conduct an aerial herbicide application to retain the conifer component, as hardwood suckers grow far quicker than conifer seedlings."

Work on forest renewal has required steps throughout the year. McClinchey continued, "Every fall, we survey all areas cut in the previous fiscal year aerially via helicopter, and follow some of these surveys up with ground checks, to determine the most appropriate treatment package for each harvest block."

This spring has seen planting activity taking place. "This year, all tree planting operations, totalling 1.5 million trees, have been planted in the Timiskaming District. We have aerially seeded nearly 50,000,000 jack pine seeds on 1,400 hectares of harvested area in the Elk Lake region. We are in the process of collecting 400 hectolitres of jack pine cones this summer. This will equate to approximately 40 million jack pine seeds.

"This Will equate to approximately 40 million fack pine seeds."

"This May, approximately 1.5 million trees were planted in the Matachewan area. Approximately 800 hectares of mechanical site preparation has occurred in the Timiskaming district. This occurred mainly in the Twin Lakes and Coleman Township areas, with some additional mechanical site preparation occurring around Matachewan. We have an additional 500 to 1,000 hectares of mechanical site preparation to complete between Elk Lake and Gowganda. We have approximately 2,000 hectares of aerial herbicide spraying to complete in the Temiskaming District. This will occur from early August through until roughly Labour Day."

Tree planting, which has already been completed for this year, is done manually. McClinchey



"Mechanical site preparation is completed with a skidder equipped with rotating hydraulic discs that scarify the ground to displace duff and slash and expose mineral soil. This creates ideal conditions for planting tree seedlings or receptive seedbeds for aerial seeding.

"Aerial seeding is broadcast from an aeroplane at a rate of 35,000 seeds per hectare," Mc-Clinchey explained.

He added that the cones used have been collected manually by pickers in cutovers.

Aerial herbicide application will be done later in the summer, and helicopters used will be equipped with a spray boom and a large holding tank containing a mixture of herbicide and water. The concentration of the mixture of herbicide and water will depend on the site that is being sprayed.

As well as forest renewal, the activities create employment.

"Tree planting itself supports approximately 50 to 60 seasonal tree planters and five to 10 supporting supervisory staff for roughly two months during the spring/summer. The mechanical site preparation programs support approximately 10 employees including operators and a foreman throughout the summer. We have five to 10 cone pickers on an annual basis. The aerial seeding program supports a pilot and one or two crewmen. The aerial herbicide program supports roughly three to five pilots and one or two crewmen."

McClinchey noted that "the process of growing tree seedling also provides employment - probably 10 to 15 seasonal greenhouse workers and maybe five permanent employees at the greenhouse."

This year's tree-planting activity did experience an impact from COVID-19, but the work had to be carried out.

McClinchey explained, "The COVID-19 outbreak had a significant impact on the tree planting program given the size of the camps required to support the program, and it had a minor effect on other programs due to the smaller number of employees required.

"The COVID-19 outbreak necessitated some considerable modifications to the tree planting program. This included social distancing within camps, continuous sanitization of vehicles, the use of masks where social distancing is a challenge (in vehicles and buses), restricting visitors to camps and restricting travel in and out of camps by treeplanters.

"It is important to note that the treeplanting program could not be cancelled, as a deposit on tree seedlings is made one year in advance of the planting of those seedlings."

The forest renewal program is supported through the Forest Renewal Trust Fund.

McClinchey outlined, "The Temiskaming District encompasses the Timiskaming Forest and the Temagami Forest. The Timiskaming Forest is managed by the Timiskaming Forest Alliance, a coalition of forest industry members with operating facilities in the Timiskaming Region. The Temagami Management Unit is managed by the MNRF. First Resource Management Group is contracted by both the Timiskaming Forest Alliance and MNRF to undertake forest management planning and renewal program implementation on these units.

"When wood is harvested from Crown land, consuming mills are required to pay stumpage, which is a price per cubic metre for the right to harvest wood. A portion of these revenues go towards the Forest Renewal Trust Fund, which is used to pay for renewal activities such as those described above."

Although spring planting is finished, forest renewal activities will be continuing throughout the year ahead.


