

Silver Capital of the World

Cobalt always welcomes visitors to come to see the historic town and cradle of mining.

There are many ways to view and enjoy all that the town has to offer.

As with all attractions this year, we ask that you phone ahead to any of the sites to ensure they are not closed due to COVID-19 restrictions.

COBALT MINING MUSEUM

Silver was discovered in Cobalt and the surrounding area, known as the Cobalt Mining Camp, in 1903 when the Temiskaming & Northern Ontario Railway was being constructed to open up transportation into the north. Silver was so plentiful in and around Cobalt, that miners simply followed the veins, resulting in a honeycomb of tunnels and shafts below the town and throughout the surrounding area.

The Cobalt Mining Museum at 24 Silver Street tells this story in detail. The presence of so many people of so many skills and with so much wealth resulted in many firsts in the town, including participation in the first National Hockey League games,

and the establishment of the Ontario Provincial Police. During the summer, the Cobalt Mining Museum offers tours of the underground Colonial Mine adit where visitors can get a sense of the experience of miners of those early days.

HERITAGE SILVER TRAIL

The Heritage Silver Trail, with approximately 20 mine and related sites, also begins in Cobalt, and the museum can provide a brochure to people who wish to take the self-guided driving tour, which provides a greatly expanded view of the silver boom activities.

COBALT WALKING TOUR

Visitors can also pick up a booklet which will explain the various points in the town and the importance of the structures which still stand. In recent decades, several murals have been created throughout the town, telling Cobalt's story in large visuals

DRUMMOND CAIRN

Beside the Paul Penna Library is the Drummond Cairn, erected in tribute to Dr. William Henry Drummond, a Montreal physician who wrote poetry about the French Canadian people he cared for. Reflecting on experience

BUNKER MILITARY MUSEUM

Cobalt's role in world history was not contained to mining. Many of its men and women participated in the World Wars.

Jim Jones was one of those and following the Second World War he established a significant collection of artifacts relating to the wars of the twentieth century and earlier.

After his passing, the collection eventually came into the hands of a dedicated group of volunteers who were provided a modern museum space by the town on the lower floor of what is known as the Fraser House at 24 Prospect Avenue.

Uniforms from many countries and wars, as well as other artifacts and documents, are professionally maintained and displayed in the Bunker Military Museum.

The museum also has in its collection a Bren gun carrier (which is mobile), and an anti-aircraft gun mounted in the nearby cenotaph park.

An Inspiring perspective

Perhaps the most spectacular point in the entire district is that of Devil's Rock overlooking beautiful Lake Temiskaming.

Devil's Rock can be accessed by a three-kilometre hike from Bucke Park (accessed from Silver Centre Road at a point about three kilometres southeast of North Cobalt).

A secondary access site, which is two-kilometres long, can also be found another kilometre to the south from the first access point.

The lookout from Devil's Rock provides hikers with a majestic view of Lake Temiskaming. The cliff rises 300 feet above water and features a commanding rock profile which appears to be looking out over the lake.

Before visiting, contact the City of Temiskaming Shores to ensure the trail is open and restrictions have been lifted after COVID-19.

The height of winter fun

The Tri-Town Ski and Snowboard Village is a popular destination throughout the winter months. Downhill skiing, snowboarding, tubing and visiting with friends in a newly constructed ski chalet make this the place to be from January to April of every year.

The ski village hill, located on Silver Centre Road in Lorrain Valley, offers a spectacular view of Lake Temiskaming from its peak.

The modern facility provides an easy lift to the top from which point skiers will have a spectacular view of Lake Temiskaming.

Day and half-day passes are available, as well as equipment rentals.

Relecting on experience

The arrival of the Europeans to the area can be marked in many locations and one of the most historic sites is that of the Old Mission on Lake Temiskaming at what is known as the Narrows. This is the location of the Old Mission which was established by Catholic missionaries in 1866. The site is now the location of the Old Mission Resort. Owners welcome visitors to the site, and note that it is an ideal location for gatherings such as family reunions. Visitors are asked to call ahead to ensure no other activities are already taking place, and also to ensure access to the site is not impacted by COVID-19 restrictions. To get there, take the Silver Centre Road (Highway 567) eastward through North Cobalt and follow it for approximately 20 kilometres to the Old Mission Road and follow the road for approximately another 4.5 kilometres to the site. The four elements of Haileybury

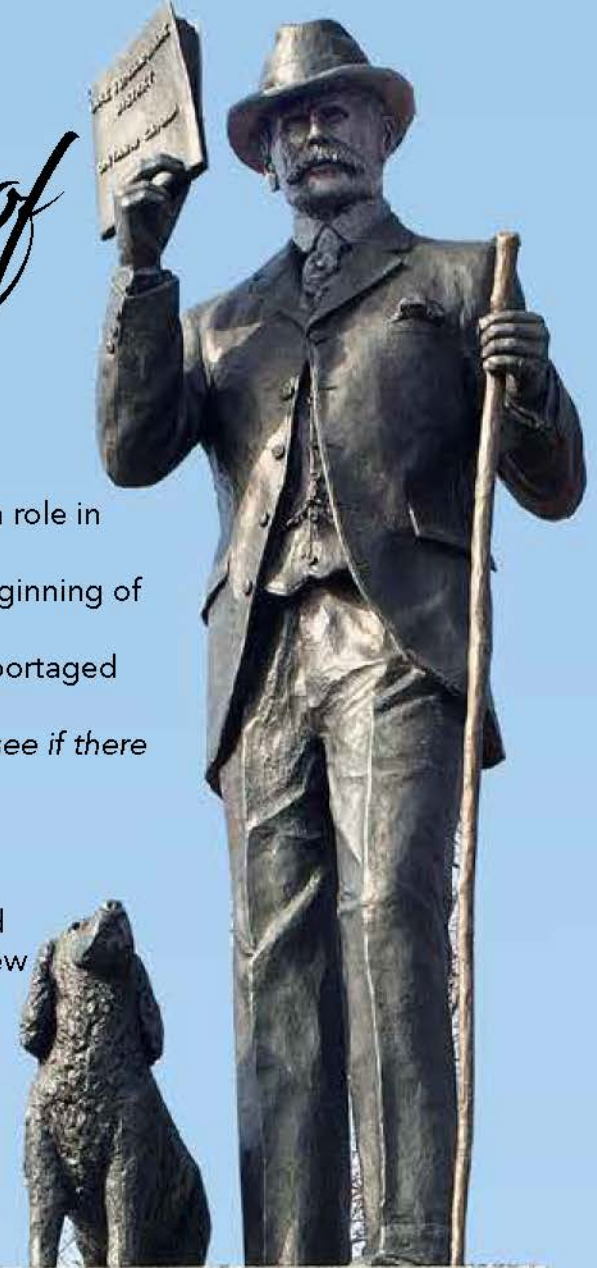
The four elements--water, earth, fire and air--have all had a role in creating the unique setting and history of Haileybury. The geography of Haileybury and area has been at the beginning of its story from time immemorial. The site was a camp location for Indigenous people who portaged across the land to the shore of Lake Temiskaming. *Before making plans to visit the attractions, call ahead to see if there are any restrictions because of the COVID-19 pandemic.*

CHARLES COBBOLD FARR STATUE

Hudson Bay depot manager Charles Cobbold Farr noticed the location and set about developing the location as a new community and devoted his life to attracting settlers. A statue of the famed founder of Haileybury, with his dog, can be seen in the Cenotaph Park on Main Street across from the Haileybury Court House.

The development of the community moved slowly until silver was discovered in the Cobalt Mining Camp to the south in 1903.

Suddenly Haileybury sprang to life. Its Lakeshore Drive, overlooking Lake Temiskaming, became the prime location for mine managers' grand homes, and the town became the centre for transactions taking place as a result of the discovery of silver, since alcohol consumption was not allowed in Cobalt.





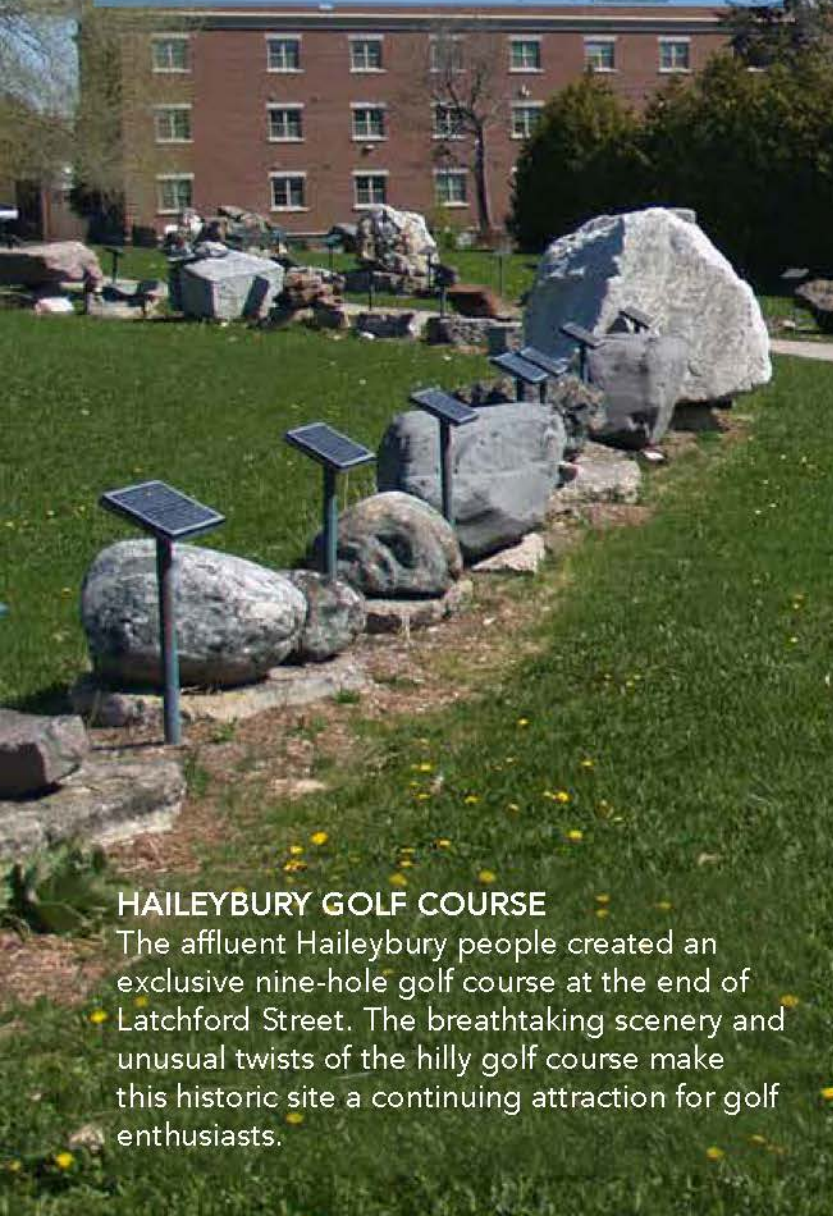

ROCKWALK PARK

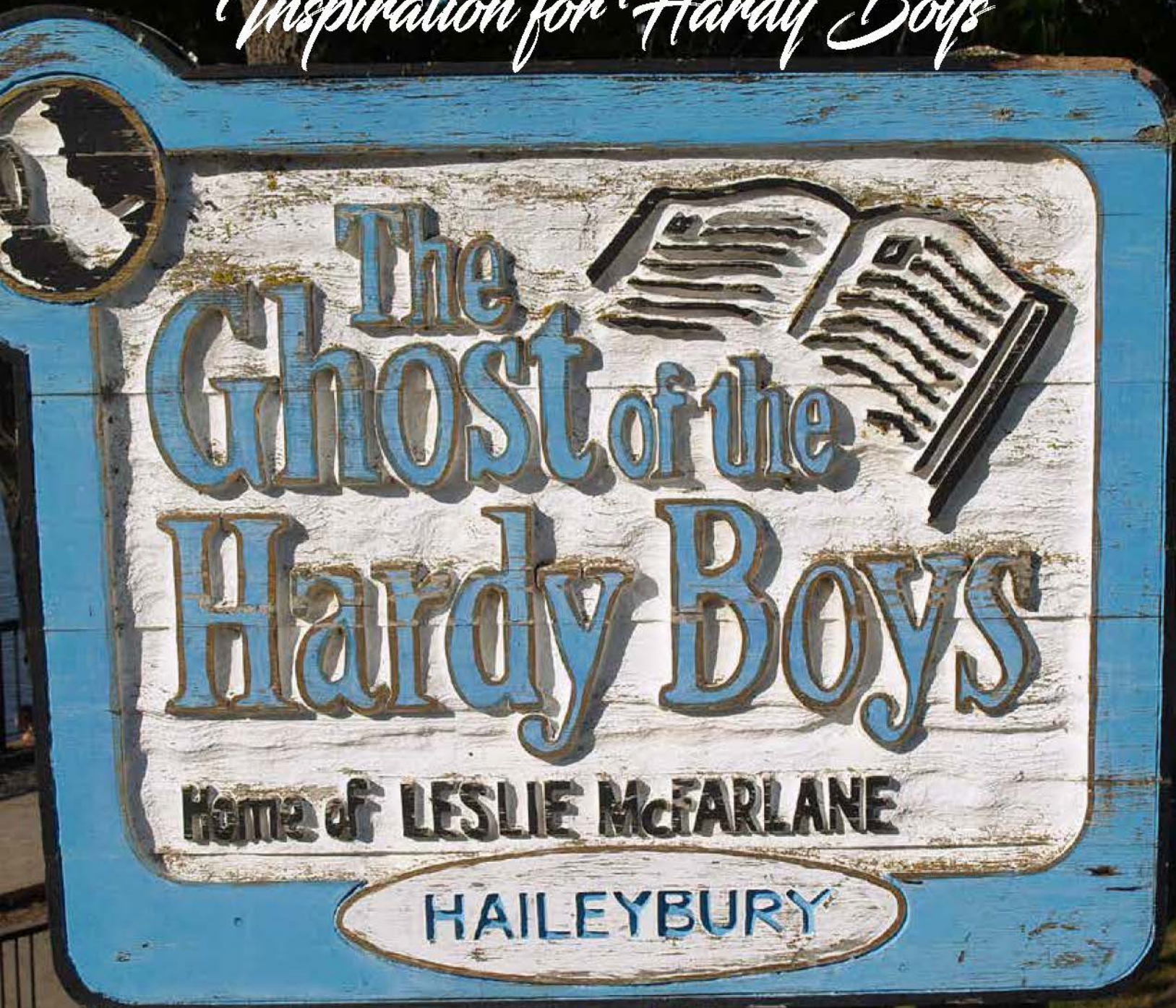

Inspiration for Hardy Boys



HARDY BOYS AUTHOR

Among those who arrived in Haileybury in those early days was John McFarlane who took up the position of principal of Haileybury Public School. He had four sons, one of whom was Leslie McFarlane who went on to pen the majority of the Hardy Boys stories under the pseudonym of Franklin W. Dixon. Leslie McFarlane grew up in Haileybury and remained as a resident until he was a young man. Locations where he lived or worked have plaques posted indicating the fact.

GREAT FIRE STATUE

The area's surrounding industry, which included logging and agriculture, continued to thrive until the Great Fire of 1922 destroyed at least three-quarters of the town, killed 11 people and left 3,500 people homeless. The October 4 fire continued across the district and into Quebec, causing destruction and more loss of life. Many residents of Haileybury took refuge during the night in Lake Temiskaming. A statue depicting the event can be seen at the Haileybury waterfront.

TEMISKAMING ART GALLERY

As the town redeveloped, a strong interest in the visual arts emerged, and artists worked together to create a public art gallery wing at the Haileybury Public Library. In recent years a dedicated location was established at the Temiskaming Shores City Hall, located on the shore of Lake Temiskaming on Farr Drive.

ENCLOSED POOL

Throughout the summer months, Haileybury is one of the popular destinations for beach goers. The town created an enclosed outdoor pool, which is part of the lake but separated by a large constructed berm to protect the shore from the incoming waves, and provides a level of water quality treatment. With imported white sand over the sloping beach, and a nearby waterslide, a raft, as well as two nearby play areas for children, the park offers much to visitors.

HAILEYBURY MARINA

The Haileybury Marina immediately south of the swimming area has 176 slips, 92 with water and hydro hook-up. There is also a boat launch.

Staying Active

BASEBALL AND TENNIS

At the south end of town on Morissette Drive the Rotary Farr Park offers two baseball fields (both lit) with nearby washroom facilities.

There are also tennis courts available for the public.

STATO TRAIL

The South Temiskaming Active Travel Organization (STATO) trail has its southerly most point at this location and runs for 21 kilometres northward, mainly along the lake's edge, through Haileybury, New Liskeard and into Dymond Township. The paved trail is perfect for bicycling, rollerblading, running and walking.

The mile-long beach of New Liskeard

Enjoy the quiet hum of New Liskeard. It's beautiful mile-long waterfront park, complete with a boardwalk and paved trail, wrap along the shore to offer an opportunity to walk or bike for a regular workout. Along the way, two playgrounds are in place where children can enjoy some time swinging, sliding and playing with family and friends.

There are also tennis courts and basketball courts for teens and adults.

At the south end of the park there are regular gatherings for baseball and soccer games.

The New Liskeard waterfront trails are one component of the STATO (South Temiskaming Active Trail Organization) trail which connects Haileybury, New Liskeard and Dymond Township. The majority of the trail follows beautiful Lake Temiskaming's shoreline and provides opportunity for non-motorized travel.

New Liskeard's waterfront includes the Waterfront Pool/Fitness Centre with a well equipped fitness centre with numerous components, as well as an indoor pool complete with a slide.

Users can also book a court for a game of squash.

Further along the waterfront is a 106 slip marina for boaters.

Summer park users can enjoy a stop at a confection stand where they can purchase hot food, ice cream and cold drinks.

There is also a mini-putt for further enjoyment.

The trail, which follows both sides of a branch of the Wabi River, leads hikers past Chester's Falls as well as a number of other smaller cascades.

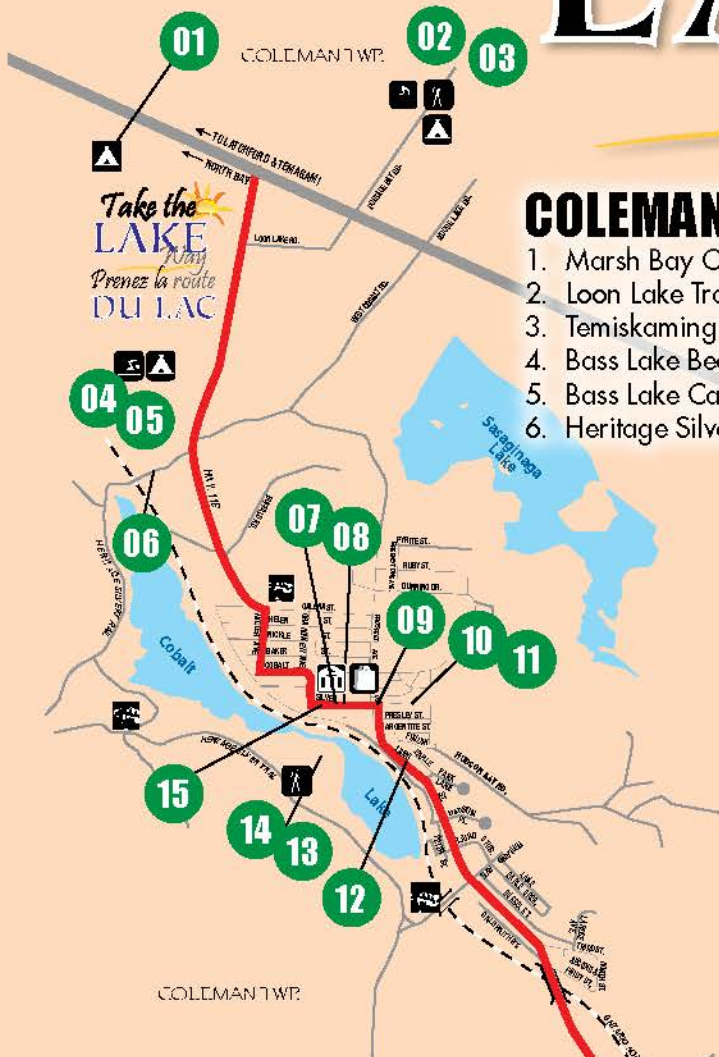

The park is now owned by the City of Temiskaming Shores, and is maintained as a recreational site.

Access to the park is off Highway 65 West on Pete's Dam Road, just a short drive west of New Liskeard.
