able to complete a few socially distant cycling expeditions and in mid-summer, meet for physically distant training at the outdoor pool in Earleton.

In September, the Pool and Fitness facility was able to re-open and our club resumed training but it was very different. There has been an enthusiastic response from swimmers and it won't be long before they are all back in form. We're looking forward to a resumption of competition as soon as Swim Ontario deems it safe to do so.

But in the meantime, it's fun to enjoy our belated Christmas gift exchange and to honour our swimmers who have hung in through the Year of Courage. A plaque to recognize their achievement will be on display in the TNL case at the Pool and Fitness Centre.

We wish our swimmers and coaches Bruce Cull, Liam Hopkins, Audrey Marquis and Chris Johnston a successful season. Thanks to all of our executive and swim parents who have supported us with fundraising and faith in the continued future of the club. We are so glad to be back in the water.

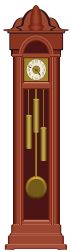

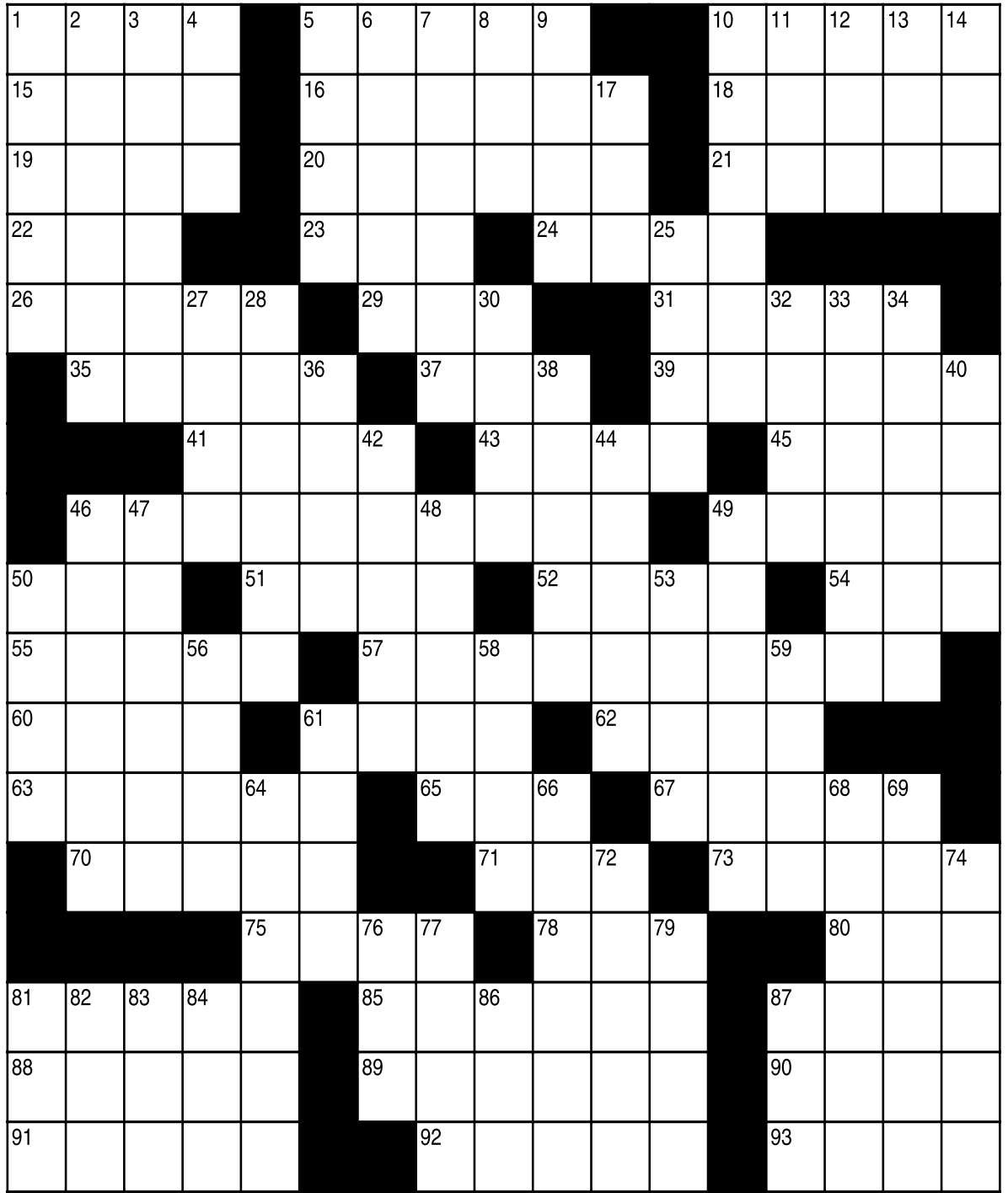
