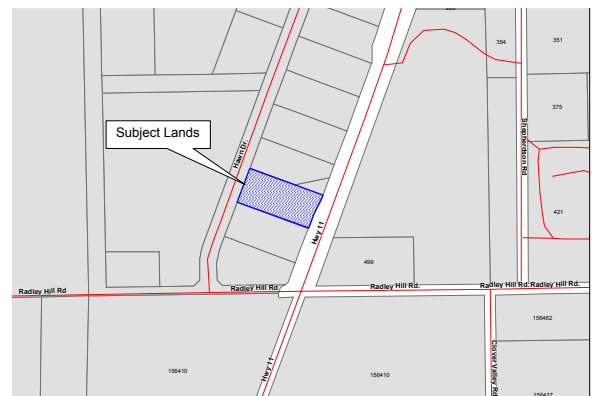

The application proposes to rezone the subject land from Manufacturing Industrial (M2) to Manufacturing Industrial Exception (M2-#) to add "motor vehicle washing establishment" as a permitted use on the subject property. The property owner intends to build a transport truck / large vehicle washing facility on the adjacent property to the north and the subject property will be used as the ingress point and driveway to access the truck wash facility. 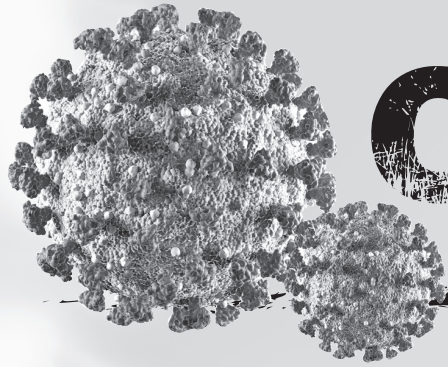
