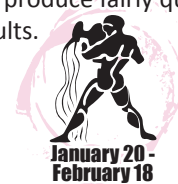

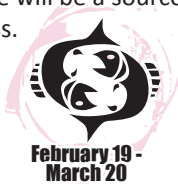

Ontario Provincial Parks Day Pass Lending Program

Ontario Parks has provided three free vehicle day-use permits for members of the Temiskaming Shores Public Library so they can enjoy using its network of provincial parks. The pass is for day use entry for all occupants of a vehicle (excludes buses). Be sure to check the Ontario Parks website for up-to-date information on their COVID-19 protocols. The Library also has backpacks, walking poles and books on hiking and camping to complete your trip!

Here's what you need to know

- There is a limit of one pass per library card.
- You may place a hold to reserve your pass in order to plan for trips.

- Overdue fees for late returns and replacement fees for lost passes will apply.

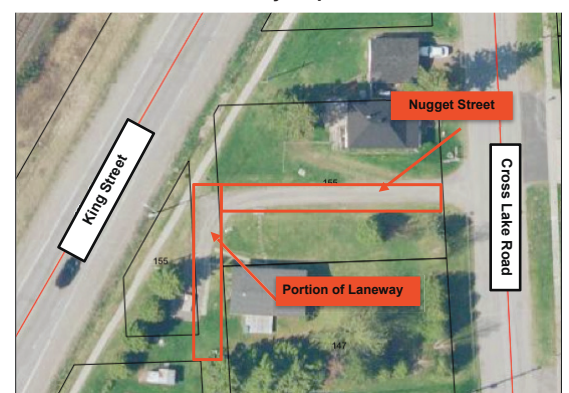

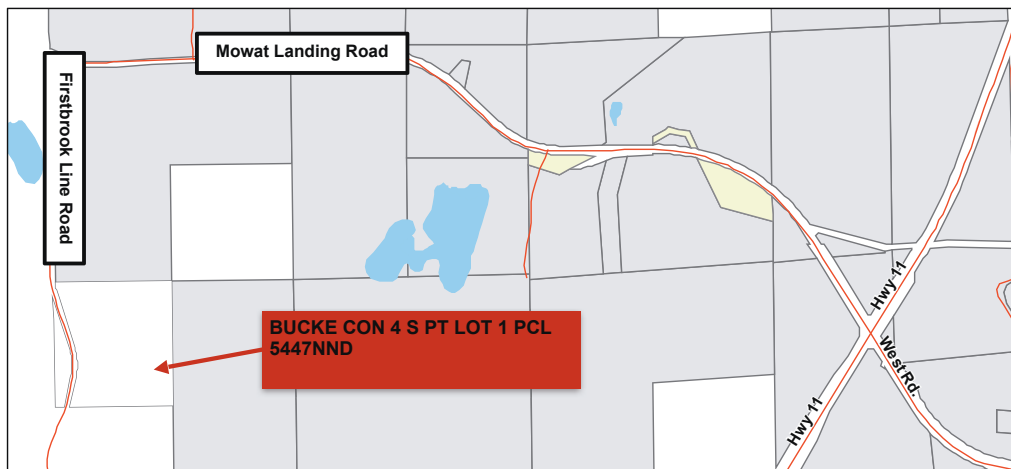
