Being vaccinated also helps prevent the virus from spreading to family and friends, and to people more likely to get very sick from COVID-19. The more people who are vaccinated, the sooner everyone can return to a more normal life.

Youth and their families can book NOW into any of our upcoming clinics.

COVID-19 VACCINE UPDATE

All individuals 12 years of age and older are now eligible to receive the COVID-19 vaccine.

Individuals 70+ and anyone who received their vaccine on or before April 18 are now eligible to book a second dose in the provincial booking system. Individuals who received their first dose of the AstraZeneca vaccine are now also eligible to book their second dose appointment at an interval of eight weeks or more with informed consent.

We are ENDORSING the mixing of mRNA vaccines so if you received Moderna for your first shot, you are now able to have Pfizer for your second dose. Under the advisement of NACI and the Ontario Government, mixing mRNA vaccines is safe and effective.

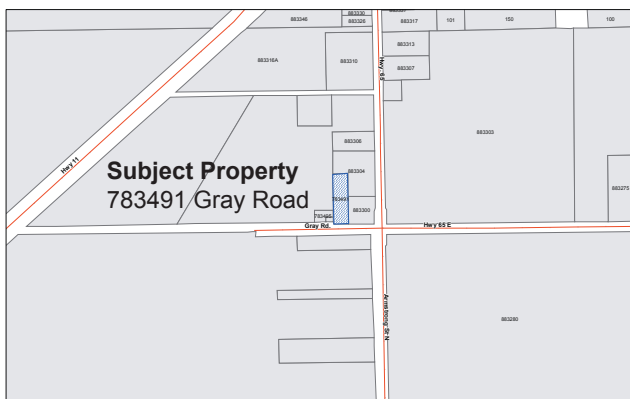

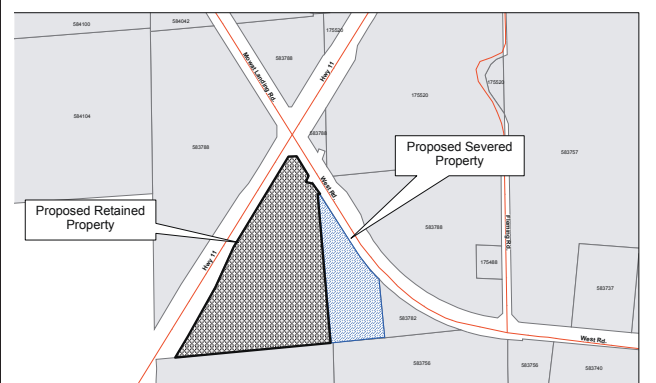
