












History and nature merge

Surrounded by forest, there are numerous trails that provide varied experiences regarding nature and also history.


The town sits on the edge of Bay Lake and the historic Montreal River which cuts through Northeastern Ontario over 220 kilometres.

The quiet waterfront is a favourite place for fishing, swimming, enjoying a picnic and the adjoining playground. There is also a nearby campground.

Visitors can also arrange for a tour of the Latchford House of Memories or the Logging Hall of Fame.

Latchford is proud to be the birthplace of Sergeant Aubrey Cosens for whom the main bridge is named. Cosens was one of 16 Canadians to receive the Victory Cross for his services to his country in World War II.



The tales of Devil's Rock North Cobalt evil's Rock on the edge of Lake Temiskaming is the doorway to the magnificent countryside of the region known as Lorrain Valley. Accessed by Silver Centre Road through North Cobalt and two possible foot trails (one about two kilometres long from the road, and the other about twice that length from Bucke Park), Devil's Rock stirs the imagination. Thought to have inspired the story-telling of Hardy Boys ghostwriter Leslie McFarlane, Devil's Rock is the central piece of many tales, from the times of the Algonquin people who lived in the region for thousands of years and spoke of small manlike creatures who lived among the rocks, or the maiden who flung herself from the top to escape marrying a man she did not want, to the legends of miners who scaled its 300-foot cliff at night with headlamps in search of silver, and the artistic endeavours of artists and photographers alike. From the height of Devil's Rock hikers can see the far shore of Quebec. The cliff face is part of the Temiskaming rift valley, and speaks to the ancient geological history of the region, and more immediately, the beauty of Lake Temiskaming. 
The silver boom in neighbouring Cobalt bolstered the thriving business community of Haileybury as a centre where deals were struck, ores were analysed, and mansions sprang up.

Lakeshore Road is a good place to find many of those original arts and crafts-style homes (now known as Millionaires' Row), some of which were the first in the region to have electricity.

The museum also relates the town's history of logging, boating and as a centre of justice as the district seat.
