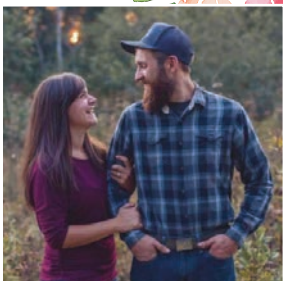

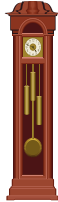

How to prevent professional burnout in the agricultural industry



The constant stress of the job has many people involved in the farming industry dealing with the effects of major burnout. Massive fatigue, feelings of failure and disinterest, loss of appetite, lack of concentration and behavioural changes (withdrawal, aggression, etc.) are extremely prevalent among farmers everywhere.

Concerning statistics

The World Health Organization estimates that people who work in agriculture have the highest risk of experiencing psychological stress and suicide. The risk is two or three times higher for farmers. This can be explained by a combination of factors including heavy workloads, unpredictable weather, market instability, globalization, quotas, debt and environmental concerns.

Preventive measures

In order to prevent burnout, managers can:

- Evaluate timetables and reg-

ulate workflow to maintain a proper work-life balance for employees.

- Provide ongoing training for employees.
- Develop mechanisms for participation.
- Recognize employees for their work.
- Set clear expectations for each worker and make sure everyone understands them.
- Develop a support system for your employees.
- Hold regular team meetings to collectively solve problems within the company.
- Educate your employees about burnout and how to prevent it — and the various support resources available to them.

Individual strategies

It's important for individuals to develop strategies in order to take care of themselves (meditating, listening to music, reading, stretching, etc.) to preserve their mental health.
