Courting success

TDSS Saints end season with NEOAA victory

TEMISKAMING SHORES — Put a bunch of athletic girls on a basketball court who are friends, together with two enthusiastic, dedicated coaches backed by the support of their school and you have a winning combination.

The Timiskaming District Secondary School (TDSS) Saints Junior Girls basketball team capped off a winning season with a North Eastern Ontario Athletic Association (NEOAA) championship in Kapuskasing in mid November.

This would be the equivalent of winning an OFSAA championship, the highest level attainable for a high school sports team.

The Ontario Federation of School Athletic Associations does not host a junior girls basketball championship so NEOAA is the top level achievable.

TDSS teachers Dana O'Donnell and Scott Mackey coach the team.

"The junior girls were a superior and hard working team this year," said coach Dana O'Donnell in an email interview.

The coaches felt it was gratifying to see their team progress during the season and have success due to hard work

and discipline.

The Saints began their South North Eastern Athletic Association (SNEOAA) season by bouncing the big orange ball down the court in their first regular season game at home on September 20.

They rarely looked back from that moment onwards as they dominated with a SNEOAA league record of 7 wins and one loss. The loss came at the hands of their cross-town rivals, the Ecole secondaire catholique Sainte-Marie (ESCSM) Apollo team.

On October 12 the team travelled to the Scarlet and

Gold Tournament in North Bay where they won the championship defeating the hometown Scollard Hall girls by three points in a closely fought matchup.

Saints player Shannon O'Reilly was named Most Valuable Player of the Scarlet and Gold Tournament.

Continuing their winning ways the Saints attended the Sister Fay Tournament in Timmins on October 26 coming away with a record of two wins and a loss.

From there the team hosted the SNEOAA Championship Tournament on October 30 de-

feating Englehart High School and ESCSM in a round-robin format to win the championship.

Up next was the challenge of competing at NEOAA in Kapuskasing.

The Saints defeated Kapuskasing High School and then tipped off against O'Gorman High School in the championship game to claim the NEOAA Championship.

The final score against O'Gorman was 48-34.

This victory hadn't been accomplished by a TDSS junior girls basketball team in almost a decade noted O'Donnell.

O'Donnell said the makeup of her team leaned a little to the green side as it included six returning players and eight first year players.

She attributed the success of the Saints to "speed and aggressive defense."

She anticipates having a skilled team to work with next year but acknowledges she will be without a few key players as they move on to the senior team.

"We will continue to grow next year while the second year players will move to the senior division."

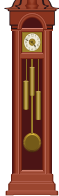

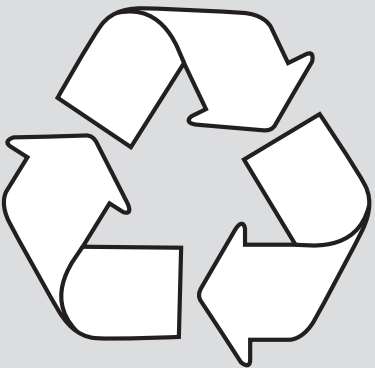

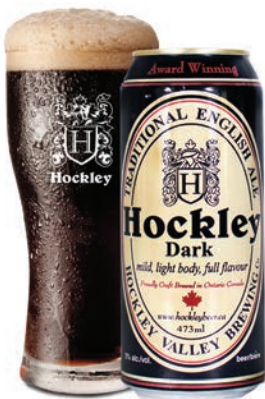
